In 1949 a new crop of Hollywood types made Del Mar the spot to be for summer frolic. Among the celebs who joined in the turf and surf fun that year were Lucille Ball, Desi Arnez, Betty Grable, George Jessel, Mickey Rooney and Jimmy Durante. Durante became such a regular that the track eventually named its turf course in his honor.



Bing Crosby makes one final visit in 1977 to the track he founded. His memory lives on at Del Mar each summer, though, by virtue of lore, legend and his now famous rendition of "Where the Surf Meets the Turf."
